 US\$4.1 billion in 2020 nonfuel mineral production (5th amongst U.S. states)







- Quality of the geological database










Minnesota's 2020 Fraser Survey Rankings










Public Policy Questions – Cost of Doing Business






Norway

- Initiating environmental review process for mining seafloor metal deposits



Sweden

- 13 Active Metal Mines
 - Iron ore
 - Copper-Nickel-PGM
 - Gold
- Europe's Leading Mining Nation
 - 91% of iron ore production
 - 9% of copper production
 - 39% of lead, zinc, silver & gold
