What is the USGS Earth MRI Program?


The Earth Mapping Resources Initiative (Earth MRI) is a collaboration between the US Geological Survey and the Association of American State Geologists. Its goals are:

- Improve knowledge of the geological framework of the US
- Identify areas in the US that have potential to contain undiscovered critical mineral* resources

*"a non-fuel mineral or mineral material essential to the economic and national security of the United States, which has a supply chain that is vulnerable to disruption, and that serves an essential function in the manufacturing of a product, the absence of which would have significant consequences for the US economy or national security." (82 FR 60835, 12/26/2017)

The Minnesota Earth MRI collaboration involves the Minnesota Geological Survey, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, and the Natural Resources Research Institute
