2017 – Start of Relocation

- The relocation was prompted by Hibbing Taconite extending its mine pit into an area that was primarily owned by the company.
- The previous mine view had been at that location for years, through a lease agreement with Hibbing Taconite.
- The city of Hibbing and Hibbing Taconite agreed to a land swap to accommodate both the new viewing area and some additional property for future mining.
